Celebrating 100 Years!



2023 marked the Library's 100th Anniversary! The Library was established in 1923 with 204 donated books in Otto Raether's confectionary store in downtown Romulus. In 2023, our community enjoys a newly renovated Library serving over 42,000 Romulus and Huron Township residents with tens of thousands of items available for checkout in both print and downloadable options. The 100-year celebrations began with a History of the Library presentation in May. A special 100 Years story time and mini-parade was held

this summer with our story time kids and a new logo was created to commemorate the anniversary. Thank you to everyone who helped us celebrate and to all our supporters over the years!

We also celebrate our amazing staff. This summer, a major staff restructuring took place and the Library Board approved the creation of several full-time positions. A number of staff enthusiastically accepted promotions, including members of our outstanding new Leadership Team. Staff have already initiated new programs, procedures, and partnerships. We are working closely with area schools on a collaborative community effort to support our kids and educators and to get a library card in the hands of every student. To better serve the community, library hours were expanded beginning July 1, 2023 and we are now open at 9:30 a.m. Monday through Saturday.

I hope you have a library card and use it often. If not, stop in and get one and start accessing all the Library has to offer, including books, DVDs, downloadables, and more. Hope to see you soon!


